



Field Reset is an important part of any competition. The Field Reset Volunteer is responsible for quickly and correctly restoring the playing field back to the original pre-match setup so that the new match can begin. The diagram above gives you a visual of what the pre-game setup looks like so that you can successfully reset the field for the next match, and the following instructions explain the diagram:

- A. Release pins are located on the lower corner of each alliances Cargo Hold. Pull the pin to release the Scoring Elements from each Cargo Hold. Once a Cargo Hold is empty, reposition the floor panel and reinstall the pin to set up for the next match. Crates or a bucket can be used to collect the Scoring Elements.
- B. Collect all Scoring Elements from each Depot.
- C. Place 2 Silver and one Gold Minerals onto the Sample Fields. The order should be Silver, Gold, Silver. The Gold Sample will always be placed such that the hole pattern is facing up.
- D. Randomly place approximately half of the Gold and half of the Silver game elements into each Crater. The Gold and Silver should be approximately equally distributed around the entire inside area of the Crater.
