


FIRST® RELIC RECOVERYSM Field Reset Guide

Field Reset is an important part of any competition. The Field Reset Volunteer is responsible for quickly and correctly restoring the playing field back to the original pre-match set up so that the new match can begin. The diagram above gives you a visual of what the pre-game setup looks like so that you can successfully reset the field for the next match, and the following instructions explain the diagram:

- A. Stack all Glyphs in the Glyph Pit located in the center of the field. The Glyphs can be placed in any orientation within the Glyph Pit tape lines, but must not exceed a height of 3 Glyphs stacked vertically.
- B. Return all Relics to their Alliance specific corner. Relics must be in a standing orientation and must touch both adjacent walls.
- C. Return Jewels to the Jewel platform. Each platform should have one red Jewel placed on the right, and one blue Jewel placed on the left. The orientation of the Jewels is as seen from the viewpoint of someone standing in the middle of the Playing Field. Place the Jewel holder against the wall, making sure the tape line in the middle of the Jewel holder lines up with the seam of the soft tiles.
- D. Rotate the Balancing Stones to the orientation as seen in the picture above. The edges should be parallel to the field perimeter walls.
